The Graduate is able to write and speak in French. He also has a basic knowledge of the fundamental notions of linguistics and a comprehensive literary culture. Those competences enables the Graduate to work in leisure time centers, cultural agencies, national or international non-profit organizations and to integrate State institutions, publishing houses or Press agencies.

The Bachelor's program forms and intensifies the knowledge in the field of French Studies, both in the disciplines of Linguistics and Literature as well as in the domain of Cultural Anthropology and Francophonie. The seminars and lectures are held in French. The emphasis is placed on dealing with the theoretical framework of the philological aspects of the program, on linkage of theoretical knowledge and its application as well as on communication in French (the achieved level of the French Language is B2+ according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). The program is designed to prepare students for the career of a teacher and motivates its graduates to enroll in subsequent Master's Program in Teaching.
