

Graduates of this bachelor study programme have extensive knowledge of German language and literature. Their communicative competence reaches the level B2, in some aspects level C1 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Graduates can continue studying the Master programme of Teacher Training in Arts and Sciences for Lower and Upper Secondary Schools - German.

This study programme provides education in linguistics, history of German written literature and the disciplines of culturology. Apart from theoretical disciplines there is also practical learning of German language. The emphasis is on a practice of conversation, practising writing skills, the standard pronunciation and the elimination of mistakes caused by interference with the mother tongue. They gain the knowledge of methodology during the last year of this study programme from the introductory chapters focusing on metamethodology. Students apply their knowledge and skills in a seminar which is practice-oriented. They confront it with reality, i.e. in teaching German during their assistant practice in schools. Students have a wide choice of compulsory seminars in which they have the opportunity to develop their competence in linguistics, literature and language and culturology knowledge. The main goal of the bachelor study programme is to establish basis for the Master study programme which prepares teachers of German language in primary and secondary schools. Therefore, a methodological intent of students is gradually formed in all disciplines.
