HR Excellence for GAČR / HEUROPE proejct applciations:

The HRS4R implementation process has been going on at the Charles University for several years, and the university was awarded the HR Award certificate at the beginning of 2019. The European Commission's "interim assessment" assessment of 2021 states that as part of the HR Award, we focused on the development of human potential, either by improving the work environment or in the form of skills development - various soft skills of both scientific and administrative staff, and special attention was paid to nurses. Furthermore, the selection process was changed, and the Code of Ethics was amended. The new action plan will also pay attention to **equal opportunities (including gender equality)**. During 2021, the CU Equal Opportunities Expert Group worked with other experts outside the university on equal opportunities audits. Based on the results of the audit and an extensive questionnaire survey among CU employees (academic/teachers/researchers and administrative staff), Gender Equality Plan has been created. The final text of this plan is now awaiting approval by Academic Senate of Charles University (during March 2022), which should enter into force. the grant agency. Majority of calls (H2020, TAČR, GAČR, NAKI, UNCE, START) have to have a filled in <u>faculty form</u> (GAUK projects excluded) with all necessary inforamtion to be processed through the faculty office. All applicants must be PedF CUNI employees or students
