

Procedure for Foreign Students Confirming Accommodation at the Halls of Residence at Charles University in Prague

1. Once a request for accommodation at Charles University's halls of residence has been accepted, the applicant is required to pay an accommodation reservation fee. The reservation is subject to the payment of a CZK 1,800 deposit plus a first month rent, i.e. the total amount will be CZK 5,600,- (depends on selected dormitory). This payment must be made by **31st August 2019**.
2. The above-mentioned deposit constitutes funds for paying the final month's rent.
3. When accommodated at the halls of residence in Prague, Plzen or Hradec Králové, use the following account number:

You must give the **student's name, surname and date of birth** in the message for the recipient of the payment. The student is liable for bank charges for crediting payment from an account held abroad. If the student does not cover these, the provider of the accommodation will charge these costs to the student's account.

4. In the event that the deposit is not paid by 31st of August or the payment cannot be identified, the student's reservation will be cancelled and Charles University's halls of residence and refectories will be unable to guarantee accommodation. In such cases, students may only be accommodated in the university's halls of residence if there are available rooms.
5. The voucher (confirmation of accommodation) you received from the Faculty's study department is only valid if the deposit (see paragraph 1) is paid.
6. Accommodation at the Charles University halls of residence is governed by the internal Halls of Residence and Refectory rules, which are published at www.kam.cuni.cz.
