

A graduate of the contiguous M. A. study course "Teaching of general-education subjects for basic and high schools - History" has mastered both practical and theoretical knowledge for employment in professions within the area of education; as a bearer of the M.A. grade, he or she possesses the approbation for teaching of history in second- and third-degree schools. At the same time, he or she will be qualified to work in research institutions such as Academy-of-Sciences institutes, museums or archives, or as a lecturer in memory institutions.

The study course "Teaching of general-education subjects for basic and high schools - History" is an M. A. program aimed first and foremost at history teachers of basic- and high schools. At the same time, its graduates are qualified to take up posts in specialized historical-research institutions (Academy-of-Sciences institutes, archives, memory institutions).

The study course "Teaching of general-education subjects for basic and high schools - History" targets the widening of specialized knowledge of history gathered during the B.A. course by special disciplines such as subject didactics, receiving particular attention. Here belong also such historical sub-disciplines as Foundations of visual culture, Historiography, specialization tutorial classes, contemporary history or modern historiography. As against the B.A. course, the M.A. program aims at the independent work of students, and meets their specializations, manifested especially by the choice of themes of the M.A. theses, and by the possibilities to choose among the specialization tutorial classes.
