

A graduate in training teachers of general subjects at lower and higher secondary schools – chemistry gained professional competences which justify them to teach chemistry at both lower and upper-secondary schools and enable them career growth (including doctoral studies).

The main goal of studies in teaching chemistry as a general-educating field is teacher training for elementary schools and secondary schools where Chemistry belongs among general education subjects. Except for this the graduation is supposed to enable the graduates work for institutions which are focused on education (e.g. pedagogical centres, institutions for children's spare-time activities), public administration (especially in positions with a direct contact with public), in chemistry labs etc. They can also work as employees of didactical institutions at Universities focusing on teacher training.
