

Graduates of the Master programme have extensive knowledge of German language, literature, culture and methodology which they understand in European context. Students' knowledge of German is at level C1 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

This course of studies builds on a study programme Secondary School Teacher-Training Programme and Teacher Training in Arts and Sciences for Lower and Upper Secondary Schools - German. Students are led to a comprehensive understanding of the German language system and all its aspects; the main focus is on the stylistic and pragmatic aspect. Students' knowledge of the literary component is widened by German language literary history and theory. During the study students are encouraged to reflect on the various aspects of foreign language teaching with regard to Czech language as a mother tongue. Furthermore, modern trends in foreign language teaching are introduced. All methodological subjects are closely linked to varied types of practice. The main goal of this course of studies is to prepare graduates to work as teachers of German language at various types of schools.
