A graduate of a master degree has large knowledge of Russian language, literature and culture and is able to incorporate this into a wider European context. His or her communication competence reaches the level of C1, a graduate knows linguistic didactical theory, which he or she is able to apply in their own teaching of Russian in the Czech school environment, is able to reflect and transform knowledge didactically.

The study continues a study programme called Specialization in Education with the study subject Russian Language Oriented at Education at all linguistic and literary science subjects. A student is led to understand Russian language system in a complex way and at all its levels, while special attention is paid to stylistic and pragmatic level mainly. Literary scientific aspect of the study enlarges knowledge about further fields of Russian history of literature and literary theory. Students are during their study led to reflect singular aspects of foreign language teaching with special attention to Czech as the mother tongue of pupils. Modern trends in teaching are introduced to them. Tuition of all didactic subjects is closely connected with all kinds of practice. The priority of the specialization is to prepare the graduate for the job of a teacher of Russian language at different types of schools.
