The graduate is fully qualified for the profession of physical education teacher in primary and secondary schools. He disposes profound knowledge of related disciplines. He has preconditions for graduating in Advanced Master's State procedure and follow-up doctoral studies and research in this field.

Consequent master studies of teaching Physical Education is a logical continuation of the bachelor degree of university education in the field of physical education and sport and related disciplines. Students are at the same time trained in the second subject which choice is variable.

The basic objective of the study is to prepare students comprehensively for the profession of Physical Education teachers in primary and secondary schools.

Preparation for of teaching physical education- compared with a bachelor's degree, which was focused more on developing practical skills and abilities, including methodological and organizational skills - is moving in the compulsory and optional subjects towards a didactics of Physical Education and didactics of individual sports. A group of theoretical disciplines relies primarily on, Biomechanics, Theory of Physical Education, Philosophical Aspects of Physical Culture, Kinesiology, youth sports training and others.

In the compulsory and compulsory optional subjects there are also included the disciplines that together with the didactic aspects follow the further development of motor skills and abilities and physical fitness of students. The students are in certain subjects also prepared for work with handicapped pupils. They also participate in teaching pedagogical and psychological training, including several forms of practice.

The described system of courses and subjects creates a presumption for students to undergo Advanced Master's State procedure or successful involvement into doctoral studies in one of the fields of kinanthropology.
