Graduates of the Master's (MA) study program of General Education Teacher Training for General Schools, Secondary Schools and Gymnasia, and Basic Art Schools specialized in Art Education acquire qualifications for teaching in these types of schools.

Graduates have a command of traditional as well as contemporary means of artistic expression. They use them both in their own creative work and in formulating and implementing their own conception of art education content both in school and extra-curricular practice in accordance with the existing curricula. They are qualified for educational, creative and conceptual work in diverse areas of art and visual culture, in galleries, museums and other cultural institutions.

The content of the study is based on three fundamental and intertwining fields that involve studio art subjects; subjects dealing with the theory of visual art, focusing primarily on education leading to active participation in art and visual culture; and subjects from the pedagogical and psycho-social field. The study is based on the most advanced findings and global trends in the field of Art Education, but also in other related fields. The study program is designed with a view to the fact that graduates are expected to work as qualified art teachers or guide creative courses for children and adults in informal educational facilities and cultural institutions.
