The graduate has knowledge and practical skills in education of people with disabilities and social disadvantage. S/he has knowledge from the field of special education and its instructional disciplines, of special educational assessment and complex rehabilitation. The graduate manages invention methods and techniques reducing specific problems of people with disabilities across life span, and delivers adequate special education support. S/he knows communication techniques and manages to work with ICT.

Knowledge from the area of speech therapy and education of people with hearing impairment, and successful completion of state exams from these areas, ensures that the graduate is qualified to conduct assessment and intervention in schools with speech therapy and hearing impairment focus, and to work in health facilities in position of speech therapist.
